REGULATION ORDINANCE NO. 2020-130 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING REGULATION ORDINANCE NO. 2009-216 AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING PARKING AREAS FOR ALL VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF ILOILO AND PROVIDING PARKING FEES THEREOF

Sponsored by Hon. Romel D. Duron, seconded by Hon. Lyndon V. Acap, Hon. Ely A. Estante, Jr. and Hon. Alan A. Zaldivar;

WHEREAS, by virtue of the powers pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No 7160 (RA 7160), otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Government of Iloilo City is mandated to create its own sources of revenue to levy taxes, fees, charges subject to the conditions set forth by the Code and consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, Under section 132 of Republic Act 7160, the power to impose tax, fee or charge or to generate revenue is granted to the Sanggunian of the Local Government Unit, in this case the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Iloilo City, through an appropriate ordinance for that matter;

WHEREAS, pursuant to such authority provided by law, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Iloilo City hereby intends to impose parking fees for every motor vehicle parked on any portion of the exisiting parking spaces within the surrounding vicinity of the downtown area of Iloilo City;

WHEREAS, consistent with Section 130 (b) of the same code, the parking fees to be imposed by the Sangguniang panlungsod of Iloilo City are determined to be:

- 1. Equitable and based as far as praticable on the taxpayer's ability to pay;
- 2. Levied and collected only for public purposes; and
- 3. Not unjust, excessive, oppressive or confiscatory, contrary to law, public policy, national economic policy or in the retraint of trade xxx.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained, as it is hereby ordained, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Iloilo City, in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title: This ordinance shall be known as "City Ordinance imposing Parking Fees for every motor vehicle parked on the parking areas established within the City of Iloilo.

SECTION 2. Policy. It shall be the policy of the City of Iloilo to implement the mandate ed in this Ordinance in order to make efficient and effective local governance.

SECTION 3. Definition of Terms. The following terms used in this ordinance shall mean:

- A. Fee- as used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean, a charge fixed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod through this ordinance for the use of parking spaces determined herefore.
- B. Motor Vehicle as used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean all vehicles run by engine whether the same is offered for passengers or for cargoes of whatever kind of nature.
- C. Parked Vehicle as used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean, the state of th motor vehicle that is stationary for the period within which said vehicle is not limited to the time needed to pick up or set up or set down persons or goods and remains inactive in that place for an appreciable period of time;
- D. Parking, is defined as "the stopping or standing of a vehicle whether occupied or not" it is the standing of a vehicle otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloadind merchandise or passengers.
- E. Parking Area as used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean, the are set or determined by the Sanguniang Panlungsod through this ordinance as suitable for parking.
- F. Overnight Parking as used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean, parking in the parking areas after office/business hours or from 8 o'clock in the evening (8:00PM) to 5 o'clock in the morning (5:00am).

G. Waiting. As used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean, to stay in place in the designated parking areas for not more than three (3) minutes using hazard lights as an excuse for parking fees.

SECTION 4. Parking areas. The following are the areas determined as parking spaces to be subject to the imposition of parking fees:

- 1. Calazans Street fronting San Jose Church parallel parking both sides.
- 2. Ortiz Street parallel parking both sides;
- 3. Guanco Street Diagonal Parking on the left side (Across Central market) right side Central Market side absolutely NO Parking.
- 4. Aldeguer Street diagonal parking on the left side (Across Central market) right side absolutely NO PARKING;
- 5. Arsenal Street parallel parking both sides,
- 6. Solis Street parallel parking both sides;
- 7. Zamora Street Parallel Parking both sides;
- 8. Macario Peralta Street parallel parking both sides except fronting Bureau of Fire Protection and Office of the Congressman.

SECTION 5. Imposition of Parking Fees. Motor Vehicle Owners and/or persons in charge of said vehicles shall be charged the following rates and as follows:

Single Motorcycles	P15.00 Pesos for the first 2 hours
	P5.00 per hour for the succeeding hours
Three Wheeled Vehicles (Tricycle)	P20.00 for the first 2 hours
	P5.00 per hour for the succeeding hours
Light Vehicles (Sedans, SUV, Pick Up Truck, Vans, Jeepney)	P25.00 for the first 2 hours
	P5.00 per hour for the succeeding hours
Medium Vehicles (Delivery Trucks)	P30.00 for the first 2 hours
	P5.00 per hour for the succeeding hours

SECTION 6. Overnight Parking. Motor Vehicle Owners and/or persons in charge of said vehicles shall be charged for overnight parking or parked for 24 hrs at the following rates:

Vehicles	Over Night Parking Fees
Single Motorcycle and Three Wheeled vehicles	P50.00 flat rate per day
(Tricycle)	
Sedans, SUV, Pick Up Truck, Delivery Truck,	P100.00 flat rate per day

SECTION 7. Article IV Section 1 of Regulation Ordinance Number 2009-216 any person or driver of a vehicle who violates any provisions of the ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) be amended to One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00)

SECTION 8. Collection-In-charge. The City Treasurer or his authorized representative is hereby empowered to collect herein parking fees using any form of official receipt he may devise, from the conductor, driver, operator, and/or owner of the motor vehicles parked in the said designated parking areas and the same shall be recorded on a separate subsidiary ledger. Any officer of the Public Safety and Transportation Management Office (PSTMO) may be allowed to collect parking fees provided they are duly authorized by the City Treasurer.

The City Mayor or its authorized representative is likewise empowered to collect herein parking fees and authorize to enter into Agreement with a private entity as the Mayor deemed it necessary.

SECTION 9. Implementing Office. Except with respect to the collecting parking fees, subject however, to the latter provision of the preceding section, the implementing office of this ordinance shall be the PSTMO;

SECTION 10. Implementing Rules and Regulations. The Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be prepared by the PSTMO within one (1) month after the approval of this Ordinance subject to the approval and adoption of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

SECTION 11. Repealing Clause. All other ordinances, executive orders, resolutions, regulations, or part thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and revised.

SECTION 12. Separability Clause. If any or this provisions of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 13. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval and after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Iloilo.
